<p>The area Catholics live in where they have their Church and a priest to look after them.</p>	<p>Name of the building where Catholics worship and go to Mass.</p>
<p>The Sacrament of the Eucharist.</p>	<p>To rejoice and be happy, and to do something special.</p>
<p>The Church in your parish where you go to Mass and receive the sacraments.</p>	<p>The priest who is in charge of a Church and the Catholics in a local area.</p>

<p>The name you receive when you are baptised, and usually is a person's first name.</p>	<p>When a person receives the Sacrament of Baptism they are baptised.</p>
<p>A holy person in the Bible, who wrote down or told people all about God.</p>	<p>The white dress or shawl, which is put on a newly baptised child during baptism.</p>
<p>The promises, which the parents and godparents make for the child during baptism.</p>	<p>The place in a church containing the blessed water poured onto someone when they are baptised.</p>

<p>Someone who promises to help bring a baptised person up as a Christian.</p>	<p>To pour a special oil onto someone.</p>
<p>The holy water used to baptise someone.</p>	<p>The candle given to the newly baptised child.</p>
<p>The large candle, which is lit at Easter.</p>	<p>A person who is in charge of all the people and churches in his area.</p>

<p>Third Person of the Blessed Trinity.</p>	<p>Another word for the Mass.</p>
<p>A name given to Jesus, because he died and rose again to 'save' everyone from sin and death.</p>	<p>When a man and a woman are 'married' in Church as husband and wife.</p>
<p>These are also called 'words of life', instructions which God gave to us.</p>	<p>A help or gift, which comes from God.</p>
