## GOD SPEAKS TO US IN THE BIBLE TODAY

Some pupils asked Archbishop Vincent Nichols to explain how God speaks to us in the Bible today and this is what he said:

"I just try to hear one phrase, or one sentence, and I think, 'oh that's lovely, that gives me comfort.' I try to remember it, to hang on to it. It might be something that just speaks to me. It might be that if I am upset it just consoles me. It might be because I am very happy and I think, 'oh there it is'. Then I think God uses those words to get through to

me, in a little phrase, in one sentence. So we try to listen to God speaking to us now in these words."

Another way is to choose a passage from scripture that you like or a Gospel story.

> Find a quiet place on your own. Re-read the passage very slowly, imagine yourself to be part of the Gospel scene; imagine what it would feel like; you are there with the apostles; what they would say to you if you spoke to them. Try to stay with Jesus, just be with him, open your heart to him; share your thoughts

with him. He will speak to you in the innermost core of your being.

- 2. Stay with the passage and read it over and over again.
