THE LIGHT

Aim - Understand the idea of Jesus as light of the world and to explore the image of light

St. John in his God describes Jesus as the light of the world:

*“a light that shines in the dark,
a light that darkness could not overpower.” John 1:5*

*“The Word was the true light
that enlightens all men” John 1:9*

Light is very important all through the Bible. It is also a word that appears in many other religions. Can you think why?
